REQUIREMENTS AND EXPECTATIONS

Purpose:

The requirements established for our mission trip are designed to ensure the success of the trip by developing a sense of community and trust. We will be spending a lot of time together, learning about each other and growing together in our faith. We all want to participate in a positive experience by following these guidelines.

REQUIREMENTS:

Participants must be entering the 10th grade in the Fall 2019. Participants must take an active role in planning and preparation. Participants must attend all Mission Trip meetings.

EXPECTATIONS FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS:

- Respect for everyone: participants, chaperones, Alive in You staff and those we are serving.
- RESPECT INCLUDES:
 - Treating people and their property in a manner that is fair and courteous.
 - Being open to the ideas and suggestions of others.
 - Recognizing the abilities of others.
 - Choosing language that is encouraging and conducting yourself in a manner that doesn't degrade others.
 - Helping to maintain an environment that is free of harassment, disrespectful actions and language.
 - Inappropriate characteristics include but are not limited to: use of threats or violence, taunting, use of obscene or profane language, inappropriate jokes, slurs, negative stereotyping or other offensive/intimidating verbal or physical conduct relating to an individual's personal characteristics.
- Follow directions the first time they are given.
- No putdowns or vulgar language.
- No suggestive clothing or nudity.
- Lights out at designated times.
- No drugs, alcohol or smoking.
- No sexual activity of any kind.
- No fighting.
- No stealing.
- No vandalism or mistreating the host/service facility in any way.
- No possession of anything that may be construed as a weapon or explosive.

Please note that violation of these requirements and expectations may result in the participant being sent home at his/her parent's expense.
