Reflections from Fr. Martin ~ The Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ January 28th, 2024

The 2nd reading discourages marriage...***IF*** it would interfere with our relationship with God. Marriage is not bad. It is a Sacrament instituted by Christ Himself, and therefore is actually meant, for those who are called to this vocation, to bring the spouses *closer* to God. Every “rule” the Church has on marriage is meant to ensure this mission of the Sacrament. Just a few examples from several graduate courses on the subject:

We cannot attend a “same sex marriage” because there is no such thing. Throughout history, until less than a decade ago all civilizations have deemed marriage between man and woman (XX & XY chromosomes).

We cannot bless a “same sex union” because *any* sexual activity outside of marriage is a sin... homosexual or heterosexual.

We cannot encourage couples to live together before marriage. Not only is that reserved for marriage but statistics show it ultimately dooms virtually all marriages of every faith.

Marriage is the only sacrament where the participants (spouses) confer it on each other through the vows (vs. an outside minister. The priest or deacon is merely the witness). One reason marriages are required to be in church is so that all God’s blessings may be bestowed upon this most-demanding, yet most-rewarding vocation.
