Jesus is not asking us to break the law, particularly the law of the gospel. He is calling us to go beyond the letter of the law and to deepen our appreciation of the message of the gospel. The good news of the gospel is more a matter of the heart than it is matter of the head. May we love the Lord, ourselves and our neighbors with all our heart, all our soul and all our mind.

Knights will be in the Courtyard after all Masses THIS Weekend, February 10th & 11th.


