Reflections from Fr. Martin ~ The Fourth Sunday of Lent ~ March 10th, 2024

The Psalm proclaims “Let my tongue be silenced, if I ever forget you!” That sounds harsh, but God is trying to warn us we only hurt ourselves when we forget that we need God at every moment. An element to every sin is forgetting God. This is why Sacramental Reconciliation is such a necessary treasure. Any time we commit a mortal sin (serious sin, full knowledge, full consent) we must immediately avail ourselves of this Sacrament to restore our relationship with God and remove our risk of eternal separation from God. But, even if unaware of mortal sins, every Catholic is required to Sacramentally confess their serious sins at least once a year, so that we can continue to be our best and grow closer and closer to God. Although I feel it’s ideal for each lay person to go a few times a year, Lent is that perfect time to make that minimal annual visit. Confession is only a happy occasion of restoring ourselves to our Baptismal glory as God’s beloved!
