**Reflections from Fr. Martin  
Christ The King  
November 26th, 2023**

What a perfect time for a bulletin reflection! It's the week we celebrate the gift to be most grateful for—Christ the King! My eyes continue to be opened more by the day to all the ways Christ the King expresses his love—and this overwhelms me with a greater desire to express my gratitude.

Jesus is first and foremost offering to give us more than we need to have the fullest lives we were always meant to have. He wants to totally and instantly free us from anything holding us down through his forgiveness (particularly through the Sacrament of Reconciliation—and there will be extra opportunities for this during this Advent Season). He dwells with us, heals us, renews us, strengthens us, most especially when he dwells within us in the Eucharist. But I feel we can all struggle with the reality that he is most eager to help us triumph the way we were meant to throughout every moment of every day, every challenge, every temptation, every surprise, every shortcoming, everything. We just forget this reality. All we have to do is accept His love.

And Jesus knows we need tangible reminders of his love. I see his love more than ever before through all of you—through your dedication, kindness, energy, generosity, enthusiasm, love and patience. Between our special events, and the generous outpouring for our church, I am so edified by the love and dedication which exists for this parish community. So often the help we need—his help—comes through the people who love us, and he does not want us to be shy in accepting his help—whether directly through him or indirectly through others.
