What a perfect time for a bulletin reflection! It's the week we celebrate the gift to be most grateful for—Christ the King! My eyes continue to be opened more by the day to all the ways Christ the King expresses his love—and this overwhelms me with a greater desire to express my gratitude.

Jesus is first and foremost offering to give us more than we need to have the fullest lives we were always meant to have. So often the help we need—his help—comes through the people who love us, and he does not want us to be shy in accepting his help—whether directly through him or indirectly through others.


