Reflections from Fr. Martin First Sunday of Advent December 3rd, 2023

This Sunday begins Advent, our great season of preparation! Our kneejerk reaction is perhaps intimidation when thinking of all the "holiday" preparations we feel we need to somehow cram-into our already packed schedules. We also often have so many Christmas parties to attend (and no one enjoys them more than I do!), yet so many are scheduled long before Christmas even begins!

This is contrary to the sobering tone of today's readings, which remind us to take a good look at our lives to see if we're ready to greet Jesus in-person. In other words, now is the time to determine if we're on our best behavior not just for Christmas but all throughout the year! It's wonderful that here as we have beautiful reminders to keep our focus on what's more important than creating that "perfect holiday." For example, our Advent wreaths point to the reality of the fast-approaching celebration of one of the most joyous and peace-filled days of the entire year!



Near the top of the tree you will find the ornaments from our Pastor, Priests and Deacons, who gift us and God with their love for our growth and care.


We would like each family to donate a home made or special ornament that will be hung on the tree and then saved for upcoming years. We are now collecting these ornaments!
