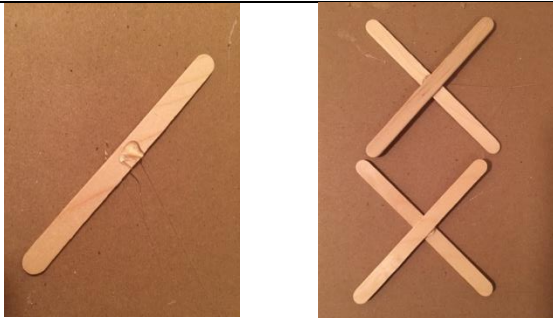
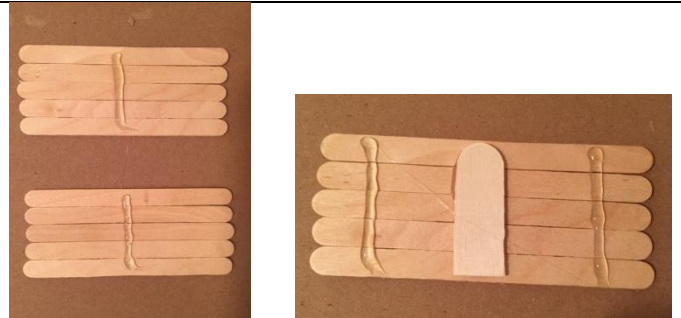


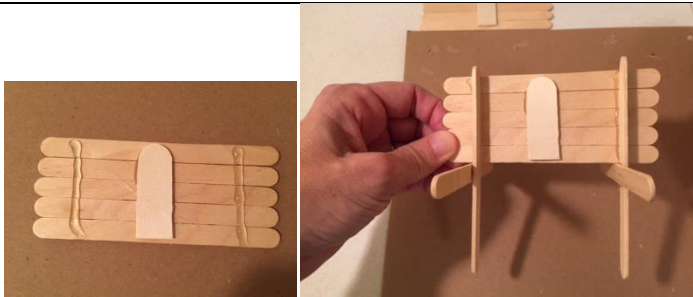
# The Manger



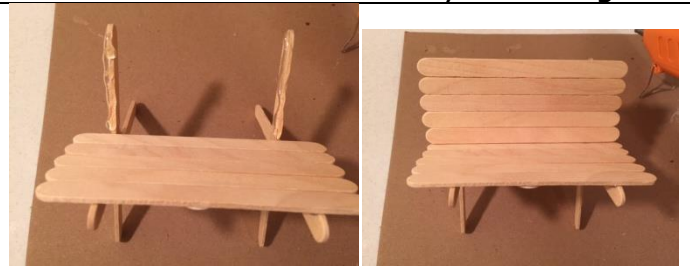
**Step 1:** Ask an adult to put a dab of glue in the middle of a stick and then press another stick on top to form an X. Make two of these and let the glue harden for a minute. These will be the legs of your manger.



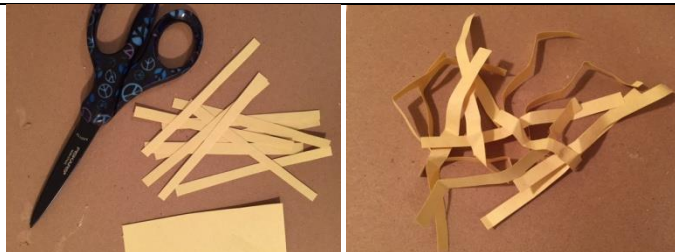
**Step 2:** Place five sticks side-by-side. Ask an adult to put a line of glue down the middle of the sticks and press one of the big flat sticks on the glue. Make two of these and let the glue harden for a minute. These will be the sides of your manger.



**Step 3:** Ask an adult to put two lines of glue on one of your manger sides. Then, press the legs on as shown in the photo. Let the glue harden for a minute.



**Step 4:** Ask an adult to put glue on the other side of the legs and press your other side piece onto the glue as shown in the photos. Let the glue harden for a minute and your manger is complete!



**Step 5:** Cut little strips out of the yellow paper and then crumple up the strips so that they look like hay. Each time you do a good deed, place one strip of hay in the manger to make a soft bed for baby Jesus.



**Step 6:** Using the markers, make a face on your baby Jesus. You can color on a blanket or clothes or use a little strip of fabric as a blanket (ask the adult to glue it on for you).
